

Participant Eligibility and Exclusion Criteria

Eligibility Criteria

- 17+ years of age;
- Must be a United States Citizen and reside in Polk County
- Must fluently speak English
- No previous record of violent felony, residential burglary or drug trafficking/distribution charges;
- Possession or possession for sale VGSCA cases and other drug related cases such as forgeries, prescription forgeries, thefts, etc. committed to support drug use;
- Must voluntarily agree to participate in the Drug Intervention Program; and
- Must have a clinical addiction diagnosis.

Exclusion Criteria

- Prior felony convictions of any violent behavior,
- Prior felony conviction of drug trafficking;
- Mental illness/danger to self or others;
- Illegal alien status;
- Currently charged with a felony of a more serious nature than the drug charge;
- Pending felony charges in another jurisdiction
- Out of state warrants;
- Current parole status;
- Unstable medical condition;
- Severe developmental deficiency; or
- Previously terminated from a Drug Intervention Program.

Services are provided and admissions/referrals are made without regard to race, color, religious creed, ancestry, gender, sexual orientation, disability, age or national origin. Complaints of discrimination may be filed with the Seventh Administrative District Office
