

Termination

Termination from the Drug Intervention Program occurs only after other sanctions have been imposed, and the participant continues to disregard program rules that are established by the treatment provider and the court. Other grounds for termination may also occur with new arrest and/or conviction on new charges, tampering with urine samples, dealing, selling, buying or possession of alcohol, other drugs, or drug-using paraphernalia at any time.

Termination may be immediate if a participant requests termination instead of serving a sanction for violating program rules, or if a participant is a danger to the physical or mental well being of other participants. A participant will not be reinstated to the program once the termination has been executed.
