**REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER FOR SENTENCING PHASE
 TO BEGIN APRIL 14, 2008**

After conferring with counsel by email, and after an ex parte hearing with the Defense on December 20, 2007, the Court hereby specially sets April 14, 2008, to commence jury selection for the sentencing phase of the above-styled case.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of Court shall re-issue juror summons to those jurors previously summoned but canceled due to the Georgia Supreme Court's acceptance of the case for interim review; said summons to be issued on January 14, 2008, as follows: the first 200 jurors to report to the Main Courtroom in the Gordon County Courthouse at 8:30 a.m., April 14, 2008, to be empaneled; the last 200 jurors shall be summoned to report at 8:30 a.m., April 15, 2008, to said Main Courtroom to be empaneled. Individual voir dire shall commence April 14, 2008, at the conclusion of preliminary matters.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, once service has been effected upon said jurors, each juror shall be mailed the questionnaire along with the Court's cover letter with instructions to return the questionnaire to the Clerk within one week. A copy of each individual questionnaire along with a juror list shall be provided to both the prosecution and defense as soon as practicable upon receipt

of all questionnaires.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all non-statutory excuses will be heard commencing March 31, 2008, at 9:00 a.m. in the Main Courtroom and continuing daily until all are resolved.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that counsel for prosecution and defense furnish to the Court in writing all anticipated follow-up questions to each individual juror, identified by juror number, no later than April 4, 2008.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that presentation of the evidence in the sentencing phase shall commence the day following the selection of the jury and four alternates.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that after hearing from both the State and Defense, and at the request of the Defense, the jury shall not be sequestered, although upon good cause showing, the Court may at a later time require the jury to be sequestered.

Counsel are hereby directed that all appropriate documents, evidence and audio-visual presentations shall be presented to the jury utilizing the Court's evidence presentation system.
