REVISED SCHEDULING ORDER


During the July 18, 2005, motion hearing, at which the Defendant, Defendant's counsel Christopher Adams, Esq., and Michelle Drake, Esq., and the District Attorney T. Joseph Campbell, Esq., were present, the Court was advised that Defendant's counsel are scheduled to begin a death penalty trial in the Brunswick Judicial Circuit on August 15, 2005, with motions to be heard on August 11, 2005. Therefore, hearings scheduled for August 12 and August 15 are hereby canceled.

It also appearing to the Court that due to the progress being made toward hearing each of the Defendant's motions filed and in order to assure the Defendant receives a full and fair hearing on each contested motion, and the orderly progress of this case, that additional hearing dates are necessary.

Taking into consideration counsel's and the Court's hearing calendars, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that additional hearing dates are set as follows: September 10, 2005; October 8 and 22, 2005; so that the Court will hear motions on the following dates, commencing at 8:30 a.m. in Courtroom C, Gordon County Annex, Calhoun, Georgia: September 9 and 10, 2005; October 7, 8 and 10, 2005; and October 22 and 24, 2005.

Counsel are further directed to furnish to the Court additional dates on which counsel are available for further hearings if necessary for November and December.
