JUROR QUESTIONNAIRE

You should answer with your true feelings, whatever they may be. Complete answers are far more helpful because they will reduce the time necessary for follow-up questioning in court. Do not assume that any of your answers will qualify you or disqualify you from serving on this jury.

It is also extremely important that your answers to these questions be exclusively your own. You must fill out the questionnaire by yourself and **not discuss the questions or answers with anyone else, including family members or close friends.**

If you need additional space to answer questions, please continue your answers on the blank sheets of paper provided at the end of this questionnaire. If you do that, please write the number of the question next to the continuation of your answer.

If you are uncomfortable completing any sensitive area, please indicate on the questionnaire itself so the matter can be taken up with you during individual voir dire. Jury service is a right and duty of citizenship. IV. Knowledge of the Case

The defendant, Jerry Jones (hereafter referred to as Mr. Jones), has pled guilty to all the charges against him. Mr. Jones's mother had the maiden name of **Judy Clements**. Mr. Jones's maternal grandparents are **John and Mildred Clements**. Mr. Jones's mother was married to Mr. Jones's father, **Jerry Jones, Sr.** Mr. Jones's paternal grandparents are **John Jones** (deceased) and **Friendly Jones** (deceased). Mr. Jones had one full biological sibling, **Chad Jones** (deceased). Chad Jones lived in Rex, Georgia and was married to **Dana Jones**. Mr. Jones's mother (born Judy Clements) was married to **Dean Schramm**, whom she divorced. Mr. Jones has a half sister from this relationship named **Tammy Schramm** (now **Tammy Wilson**). Mr. Jones's mother was also married to **Robert "Bob" Medeiros**. Mr. Jones has a stepsister from this relationship, **Hope Medeiros**.

The facts of this case occurred over the time period of January 7, 2004 through January 8, 2004. Among other things, he has pled guilty to the murders of four people. The murders took place on Pack Road in Ranger, Gordon County.

Mr. Jones's then-girlfriend is named **Melissa Ann Peeler**. The murder victims were **Tom and Nola Blaylock, Georgia Bradley, and Jerri Georgia Jones**. Tom Blaylock was shot to death. Nola Blaylock was shot to death. Georgia Bradley was strangled. Jerri Georgia Jones, an infant, was strangled.

Mr. Jones has also pled guilty to kidnapping three girls, **Brittney Mae Christine Phelps, Brandy Nichole Jones, and Tami Hope Peeler**. They were kept overnight by Mr. Jones. Mr. Jones was arrested on January 8th in Tennessee after crashing the stolen motor vehicle he was driving into a utility pole while being chased by law enforcement officers. He had the three girls

with him in his car. In connection with this case, Mr. Jones has also pled guilty to other charges, all of which are connected to the incident described above.
