REPORT OF THE JUDGE AND ORDER FOR INTERIM REVIEW

Pursuant to Section II (F)(2) of the Unified Appeal Procedure, the Court certifies that all pre-trial proceedings in the case have been completed. The Court finds that interim appellate review of the pre-trial proceedings is appropriate for arguably reversible error, as follows:


- (1) Defendant's Motion #10 challenging the array of the traverse jury, particularly the procedure used to compile the array (Hearing October 27, 2006; Order filed November 6, 2006)
- (2) Defendant's Motions #86 and #121 to suppress evidence found at the Defendant's residence and the Court's denial of said motion. (Hearing August 21, 2006; Order filed September 11, 2006)
- (3) Defendant's Motions #89 and #137 to exclude Defendant's statements made while hospitalized and the Court's ruling to allow said statement. (Hearing August 21, 2006; Order filed September 11, 2006)
- (4) The Court's colloquy and acceptance of the Defendant's guilty plea without jurors present. (Plea entered December 13, 2005.)
- (5) The Court's denial of Defendant's Motion #31(a) declaring O.C.G.A. § 17-6-4 as amended constitutional. (Order filed October 19, 2005)

(6) The Court's denial of Defendant's Motion #143 seeking to bar the imposition of the death penalty on the grounds alleged in said motion. (Hearing August 21, 2006; Order filed September 28, 2006)

Counsel for the State and Defense are reminded of their rights and duties pursuant to Section II (f)(3), (4), (5), and (6), which affords the prosecution and defense the right to "seek review of any areas of the pre-trial proceedings in which reversible error may arguably have occurred by filing with the Clerk of the Supreme Court an application to appeal any order, decision or judgment entered in the case . . ."

Let a copy be served upon the District Attorney, Counsel for the Defense, the Defendant, and the official court reporter. This Order shall be filed with the Clerk of Superior Court. The Clerk is directed to immediately transmit the record pursuant to the Unified Appeal Procedure and the Rules of the Georgia Supreme Court.
