**ORDER ON DEFENDANT'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO
OPT-IN TO RECIPROCAL DISCOVERY AND TO MAKE A SEALED
PROFFER PERTAINING TO DEFENDANT'S MOTION #111**


The above and foregoing Defendant's Motion #141 for an extension of time came before the Court, and after reviewing said motion, the Court enters the following order:

Defendant prays to make a "sealed proffer of case specific evidence" pertaining to his request for an ex parte hearing on the constitutionality of the amended discovery, in response to the Court's denial of Defendant's Motion #111. Defendant's request to make a sealed proffer is **GRANTED**.

Defendant also prays to extend the deadline for opting in until 60 days prior to the trial of this matter or until such other time as counsel is able to make a "meaningful assessment of this critical decision."

The Court **DENIES** the above request as prayed. However, the Court **ENTENDS** the time for Defendant to decide whether to opt-in to reciprocal discovery until January 6, 2006.
