**DEFENDANT'S ASSERTION OF
FIFTH AND SIXTH AMENDMENT RIGHTS
AND REVOCATION OF ANY PRIOR WAIVERS**

1 Mr. Jones, through undersigned counsel, does hereby assert his 5th and 6th Amendment (U.S. Const. amend. V & VI) rights and the rights protected by Ga. Const. art. I, § I, Par. I, XVI, XIV, and XII relative to speaking with any person other than his attorneys about anything, including, but not limited to, his history and background, the facts underlying the current indictment, any alleged involvement in criminal activity, and his political, religious, or cultural views on any subject.

2. Jerry Jones hereby provides notice that any prior waiver of any of these rights is hereby immediately revoked, and any consent or permission granted waiving any of these Constitutional rights is likewise hereby revoked. Jerry Jones hereby respectfully demands that any and all requests for any waiver of these Constitutional rights be directed solely to his attorneys.

3. In support of this notice and declaration, Mr. Jones relies upon the Fourth, Fifth,

ixth, Eighth and Fourteenth Amendments to the United States Constitution, Article I, §§ I, II, IV, V, VII, IX, X, XI, XII, XIII, XIV, XV, XVII, XVIII, XXIV and XXVIII of the Constitution of the State of Georgia, Convention against Torture and Other Cruel, Inhuman Degrading Treatment or Punishment, December 1984 Art 4 and 23 I.L.M. 1027 (Entry into force for the United States November 20 1994), Inter-American Convention on Human Rights, November 22 1969 Art 4 and 7 144 UNTS I.L.M. 673 (Entry into force July 8, 1978), International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, December 1966, Art 2(1) and 999 UNTS 7 I.L.M. 68 (Entry into force for the United States September 8, 1992), Second Optional Protocol to the International Covenant on Civil and Political Rights, December 1989 UN GAOR Supp (No 49 at 207, UN Doc. A/44/49 1989) (Entry into force July 1991), Article 18, Vienna Convention on the Law of Treaties, May 23 1969 Art 8, 1155 UNTS ILM 679 (Entry into force January 1980) as well as statutory and jurisprudential authorities cited below and all other applicable constitutional, statutory treaty, customary international law, evolving international standards, and jurisprudential authority. Defendant further asserts her right to a full and fair hearing on all issues according to both State and Federal Constitutional Law.



This assertion of rights regarding not speaking with any person of the above subjects shall include, but not be limited to jailers and deputy jailers, members of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation or Georgia State Patrol, members of the County Sheriff's office, local city police officers, members of the District Attorney's office, members of the Attorney General's office, members of any other state, county or city government agencies, and any and all agents of the foregoing, including persons within the jail, fellow inmates and members of the print and broadcast media who may or may not be urged by law enforcement

officials to engage defendant in conversations.


