ORDER

The Court, having previously received a number of requests for electronic and photographic coverage pursuant to U.S.C.R. 22, met with certain members of the media on February 29, 2008, who responded to the Court's notice of said meeting.

After consideration of U.S.C.R. 22 and the factors as outlined in O.C.G.A. § 15-1-10.1, the Court enters the following order:

The Court does not require another Rule 22 filing by those members of the media who previously filed a request, subject to the following limitations:

(1) One pool camera will be allowed in the courtroom, which will be positioned in the Main Courtroom as the Court's direction. Said camera will be provided by WTVC, Channel 9, Chattanooga, TN, unless otherwise directed.

(2) The Grand Jury Room, located in the Gordon County Annex Building, is hereby designated for media use during the trial.

(3) Still photography will be allowed in the courtroom, so long as the cameras utilized are non-flash and quiet. Still photographers shall only take photographs from the rear of the courtroom.

(4) Media equipment, including recording devices, will be placed unobtrusively so as not to interfere with court proceedings and will be installed or arranged prior to commencement of court.

(5) Only the media may photograph or electronically record the proceedings for non-official use.


(6) No child witness or prospective or actual juror shall be photographed or recorded at any time. The Court may also restrict video or audio recording or photographing of any witness at its discretion.

(7) All media vehicles will be parked in the overflow parking area only.

(8) The media shall not video or photograph any security measures taken to assure the safety of the public and the parties.

(9) The Court may amend this Order at any time in its discretion to assure the dignity and integrity of the court and the administration of justice.
