

of the trial. The prosecution has not yet rested, and the defense anticipates calling witnesses during the guilt/innocence phase.


3. There are numerous phases of the trial which have yet to occur, including a sentencing phase should the jury return a guilty verdict.


4. Mr. Adams has been in Brunswick, GA for the past month, and has had no time to devote to the preparation of the hearing currently scheduled in this case for September 9, 2005. Mr. Adams has been working an average of seventeen hours per day in preparation and trial of the Woodall case.

5. Counsel has no expectation that the Woodall trial will conclude prior to September 9, 2005.

WHEREFORE, for the foregoing reasons and any others that may appear to this Court after a hearing, counsel for Mr. Jones, respectfully requests this Court continue the hearing previously scheduled for September 9, 2005 to a later date.
