ORDER SCHEDULING ARRAIGNMENT AND MOTIONS

The above and foregoing matter came on regularly for the First Proceeding Hearing as required by the Unified Appeal procedure on April 4, 2005. Present were the Defendant, his counsel, Christopher Adams, Esq., Michelle Drake, Esq., Rodney Mathis, Esq., and the District Attorney Joe Campbell.


After furnishing the Defendant, his counsel, and the court reporter with copies of the Unified Appeal, the Court conferred with counsel on those matters to be addressed at the First Proceeding, as well as the pre-trial checklist of appropriate areas of inquiry. Prior to the conclusion of the hearing, the Court also gave the Defendant the opportunity to state any objections he may have to Defendant's counsel or the manner in which Defendant's counsel has conducted or is conducting the defense. The Defendant expressed no objections.

After discussion with counsel, **IT IS ORDERED** that arraignment and plea on the merits of the case is set for 9:00 o'clock a.m., June 3, 2005, Courtroom C, Gordon County Courthouse Annex, Calhoun, Georgia. The initial hearing on Defendant's pending motions shall be conducted following arraignment. Counsel having indicated Defendant's intent to challenge the array of the Grand Jury and Traverse jury, a hearing on said motion is hereby scheduled for 9:00 o'clock a.m., July 18, 2005,

in Annex Courtroom C.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that additional hearings as necessary on pending motions are hereby scheduled for August 12 and 15, 2005; September 9, 2005; and October 7, 10 and 24, 2005, all commencing at 9:00 o'clock a.m. in Courtroom C, Gordon County Courthouse Annex, Calhoun, Georgia.
