

The Court, however, is unaware of any threats or invasions that may have been made against Defendant in the recent past. Neither party has furnished the Court with information concerning the Defendant's safety or lack thereof.

The Court notes that Defendant has complied with and obeyed all previous orders of the Court, as expected. However, the Court will not at this time modify any of Defendant's bond conditions. Accordingly, Defendant's MOTION TO AMEND BOND CONDITIONS is DENIED. This order does not deprive

Defendant and his attorney from filing another bond modification motion
in the future should the facts and circumstances change.
