SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF COMPLIANCE WITH DISCOVERY


NOW COMES THE STATE OF GEORGIA, by and through the District Attorney, and, based upon the Defendant's election to proceed under the discovery provisions of O.C.G.A. Sections 17-16-1, et. seq., the State would supplement the previous discovery by serving the following documents upon Defendant or counsel for the Defendant:

1. A copy of the documents, x-rays and photographs relating to the identification of Body #104 as the remains of Annie Brien, consisting of 49 pages, including but not limited to the Authorization for Release of Human Remains, identification forms, DNA forms, family information forms, property receipts, notes, post-mortem dental records and x-rays, ante-mortem dental records, pathology notes, a photograph of the deceased in life, and scene photographs.

Any and all reports, documents, writings and tangible or physical evidence in the possession of the District Attorney or the law enforcement agencies which investigated this case, with the exception of work product may be examined upon request by making arrangements through the undersigned. The State shall permit the Defendant at a time agreed to by the parties or as may be ordered by the Court to inspect and copy or photograph books, papers, documents, photographs, tangible objects, audio and visual tapes, films and recordings, or copies or portions thereof and to inspect and photograph buildings or places which are within the possession, custody, or control of the state or prosecution and are intended for use by the prosecuting attorney as evidence in the prosecution's case-in-chief or rebuttal at the trial or were obtained from or belong to the Defendant. Evidence that is within the possession, custody, or control of the Forensic Sciences Division of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation or other laboratory for the purpose of testing and analysis may be examined, tested, and analyzed at the facility where the

evidence is being held pursuant to reasonable rules and regulations adopted by the Forensic Sciences Division of the Georgia Bureau of Investigation or the laboratory where the evidence is being held.




